ROTC Enrollees To Assist In Traffic Enforcement

1. The issuance by His Excellency President Fidel V. Ramos of Proclamation No. 520 declaring 12 January 1995 as a day to commemorate the celebration of World Youth Day in the Philippines has suspended classes in all schools colleges and universities in the National Capital Region from January 9-17 on the occasion of the 10th World Youth Day Celebration in Manila.

2. To assist law enforcers in directing the smooth flow of traffic on said occasion, all schools in the National Capital Region through their commandants are hereby requested to coordinate with Col. Romeo B. Maganto, Chief, Traffic Enforcement Task Force, Metro Manila Authority, National Capital Region, Orense St., Guadalupe, Makati, Metro Manila, for the utilization of the students enrolled in the ROTC program as traffic aides in different streets/thoroughfares in Metro Manila area to avoid traffic congestion.

3. The cooperation of persons/officials concerned and immediate dissemination of the memorandum is desired.
