COLLEGIATE CALENDAR FOR SCHOOL YEAR 1995-1996

TO: CHED Directors  
CHED, Higher Education Regional Offices (CHED-HERO)  
Heads, Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Non-Chartered State Colleges classified as  
Higher Education Institutions  
Heads of Community Colleges

1. The Collegiate Calendar for School Year 1995-1996 for the tertiary level is hereby promulgated.
2. As a general rule, the opening of classes for higher education institutions shall not be earlier than the first Monday of June nor later than the 4th Monday of the same month each year.
3. For the School Year 1995-1996, the following dates and periods shall be observed:
  - a. The collegiate school year will begin on Monday, June 5, 1995 and will end on March 16, 1996. Collegiate school days shall consist of not less than eighteen (18) weeks per semester and six (6) weeks for summer excluding semestral, Christmas and summer vacations. The school days shall include examination days and class days which may be subsequently suspended due to natural or man made calamities.
    - 1) The first semester will start on June 5, 1995 and will end on October 7, 1995;

2) The second semester will start on October 23, 1995 and will end on March 16, 1996; and

3) The summer classes will start on April 1, 1996 and will end on May 11, 1996.


b. Christmas vacation will begin on December 19, 1995 and will end on January 2, 1996.

4. In addition to the regular and special public holidays authorized by law under Sec. 26 and Sec. 27, Chapter 7 of the Administrative Code of 1987, the Commission on Higher Education will permit the observance of other school holidays provided the minimum collegiate school days stated in 3.a above within a semester or summer are strictly observed and provided further that a minimum of 17 student contact hours, inclusive of examinations shall be required for one-unit of collegiate academic credit.

5. Graduate schools following the trimestral system may establish their own school calendars and opening days, informing the Commission on Higher Education and the concerned CHED-HERO of their particular schedules, provided the minimum class hours and class days requirement herein above-mentioned are met.

6. The 1995-1996 CHED Academic Calendar and the distribution of class days by weeks/months per semester and summer are enclosed.

7. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Order is desired.
