SUBJECT: PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION FOR GRADUATE EDUCATION (PAGE) 32ND ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and by virtue of Resolution No. 001, series of 1995, of the Commission on banc, Regional Directors, Presidents of State Colleges and Universities, Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities, Deans of Graduate School and professors are hereby informed, thus:

1. The Philippine Association for Graduate Education (PAGE) in cooperation with the Commission on Higher Education, is scheduled to hold its 32nd Annual Convention on April 18 - 20, 1998 at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City on the theme: "Enriching Graduate Programs for Professional Practice, Industry and Public Service."
2. The objectives of the convention include the following:
 - a) to re-engineer graduate degree programs in the various disciplines, (i.e., education, science and technology, business, management, public administration, nursing and the allied medical professions, among others);
 - b) to re-structure the curriculum for quality and relevant professional practice; and
 - c) to invigorate the consummate work ethics in public service through re-inventing the traditional Filipino values.
3. CHED Regional Directors, Presidents of State Colleges and Universities, Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities, Heads of CHED-Supervised Schools, Deans of Graduate School and Professors are encouraged to participate and be actively involved in this undertaking.
4. A registration fee of P2,500 will be charged each participant to cover expenses for meals, kit, conference materials and accommodation. Expenses incurred incident to the attendance by participants to this conference shall be charged against local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private tertiary institutions shall make arrangements with their respective schools.
