SUBJECT : **REGIONAL CONFERENCES ON "THE PHILIPPINE REVOLUTION AND BEYOND IN THE CONTEXT OF THE REGIONAL PARTICIPATION" SPONSORED BY THE NATIONAL CENTENNIAL COMMISSION IN COOPERATION WITH THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL INSTITUTE**

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and by virtue of Resolution No. 001, Series of 1995, of the Commission en banc, all Presidents of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), Heads of Higher Education Institutions (PHEIs) and HERO Directors are hereby informed, enjoined and/or directed, thus:

1. The subject undertaking shall be held as follows, thus:
 - a. For Central, Western and Eastern Visayas

 - c. For Central Luzon, Ilocos, Cagayan and Bicol Southern Regions

2. These regional conferences aim to: (a) assess the overall impact of the Philippine Revolution on the various regions of the archipelago; (b) contribute to the Philippine historiography at the regional level; and (c) strengthen national identity and pride through awareness of the contributions of all Filipinos in the winning of Philippine Independence.

3. Serving as a prelude to the International Conference on the Philippine Revolution which will be held on 21-23 1996, these two-day regional conferences will be conducted in partnership with selected academic institutions which will provide substantial logistics and networking support.

4. Participants will be charged a registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) to defray the cost of a conference kit and two (2) snacks. They will assume the cost of their travel and accommodation arrangements and expenses. Expenses to be incurred by official delegates or participants of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) may be charged against their funds.


5. College and graduate-level students may attend.
