**SUBJECT: ASIA-PACIFIC YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS
CONFERENCE (AP-YEC)**


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In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and by virtue of Resolution No. 001, Series of 1995, of the Commission en banc, all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are hereby enjoined and/or directed, thus:

1. The Asia-Pacific Young Entrepreneurs Conference (AP-YEC) which will be held at the New World Hotel, Manila on September 2-3, 1996 is a project of the Philippine government, through its agencies, the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), the National Youth Commission (NYC), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and the private sector, under the aegis of the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI). The AP-YEC is being organized in cooperation with the governments of Canada and Indonesia.
2. The conference will revolve around the theme "APEC Markets in Motion: Preparing for the 21st Century." The activities include direct business matching, sharing of the most successful entrepreneurial practices in the region, lectures on APEC policies and human resource development, and site visits to factories and industrial zones which reflect the dynamic investment opportunities in the Philippines. A discussion on the "Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines-East ASEAN Growth Area (BIMP-EAGA)" will also held to intensify awareness on this new growth polygon in the Asia-Pacific region.
3. A registration fee of ~~₱~~2,500⁰⁰ will be charged to cover luncheons, dinners, snacks, business matching, round-table discussions, special events, and industry site visits.
4. Enclosed are the programme of activities, registration and payment form.
