SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO CMO NO. 39 dated 25 June 1996, ENTITLED
"IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS ON RAMON
MAGSAYSAY, JR. STUDY GRANT PROGRAM"

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and for the efficient and effective implementation of the Ramon B. Magsaysay, Jr. Study Grant Program in various State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) nationwide supporting the educational needs of the poor but deserving incoming freshmen students, Article V.I of CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 39 dated 25 June 1996, entitled "Implementing Rules and Regulations on Ramon Magsaysay, Jr. Study Grant Program is hereby amended to fully reflect the intention of the Program and further promote the welfare of the grantees, to read as follows:

Article V.1

"The Ramon Magsaysay, Jr. Study Grant Program beneficiaries enrolled in various State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) nationwide are entitled to receive free tuition and other school fees as billed by the Higher Education Institution (HEI) concerned but not to exceed **FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P4,500.00)**. Provided, that if the said amount is not wholly applied to the tuition and other school fees of the grantees, the remaining amount shall be utilized as additional allowance of the latter. This provision shall be given retroactive effect commencing school year 1996-1997."

This amendatory CMO shall take effect immediately.
