**IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE SHARING SCHEME
OF THE P45 M FUND FOR STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCs)
COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM AUTHORIZED UNDER THE "1997
GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT (GAA)"**

The following Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) on the Sharing Scheme of the P45 M Fund for State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) Computerization Program authorized under 1997 General Appropriation Act (GAA) are hereby adopted and promulgated thus:

1. The Sum of P45 M minus the mandatory reserve or the amount of P 41,750,000.00 is broken as follows:

1.1 Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses	P 20,000,000.00
minus 10 % mandatory reserve	- P 2,000,000.00
	P 18,000,000.00
1.2 Capital Outlay	P 25,000,000.00
minus 5% mandatory reserve	- P 1,250,000.00
TOTAL	P 23,750,000.00

2. The amount available for SUCs shall be shared equally by ninety-eight (98) SUCs as follows:





4. Multi-campus SUCs shall be entitled to only one (1) share.
5. This Implementing Rules and Regulations shall take effect immediately.


