**SUBJECT : MORATORIUM ON THE OPENING OF NEW
PROGRAMS IN CUSTOMS ADMINISTRATION**



In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and in the light of the recent alarming poor performance of graduates in the government licensure examination for Customs Brokers, a **moratorium** is hereby declared in the opening of new programs of Bachelor of Science in Customs Administration (BSCA) and/or as major field in the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA).

This moratorium is deemed necessary for the immediate upgrading of standards in the Customs Administration courses parallel to the on-going "re-engineering" of programs undertaken by the Bureau of Customs (BOC).

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force and effect until revoked.
