

Attached is a copy of the proposed Policies and Standards for Masters and Doctoral Programs for Information Technology for your reference.



**Remuneration of Faculty**

## REMUNERATION OF FACULTY

It is recognized that the institution offering architectural program shall have the prerogative in terms of Remuneration. However, it is the intent of this Policy Manual to set forth a basic guideline to be followed in the hiring of new qualified Architect-Instructor of the Architectural program.

### Classification of Academic Subjects

The academic subject offering of an architectural program shall be classified as and shall be compensated as follows:

#### Case Study

Assume: 1 Pay Unit = P 100.00

a. Lecture Subjects 1 Lecture Hour : 1 pay unit

1. History 1 : 3 Academic Units = 3 Lecture Hours x P100.00 = P 300.00

b. Studio Subjects 1 Studio Hour : 1 pay unit

(Visual Technology, Building  
Technology, and Graphics)

1. Graphics 1 - Architectural Drafting : 3 Academic Units

1 Acad. Unit ( Lec ) = 1 Lec. Hour x P 100.00 = P 100.00

2 Acad. Units (Studio) = 6 Studio Hrs. x P 100.00 = P 600.00

Total = P 700.00

c. Design Subjects 1 Design Hour : 2 pay units

(All Architectural Design  
Subjects)

1. Ar. Design 7 - 5 Academic Units

1 Acad. Unit (Lec.) = 1 Lec. Hour x P 100.00 = P 100.00

4 Acad. Unit (Design) = 12 Design Hours x P 200.00 = P 2,400.00

Total = P 2,500.00
