CHED MEMORANDUM ORDER (CMO)

SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF CERTIFICATE AND ASSOCIATE PROGRAMS IN MARITIME EDUCATION EFFECTIVE SY 2000-2001

Pursuant to Resolution No. R219-2000 of the Commission en banc dated June 1, 2000, and per provisions of the CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 51, s. 1997 - Policies, Standards and Guidelines for Maritime Education and for the purpose of rationalizing maritime education in the country with the end view of keeping apace with the demands of the gobal competitiveness, the following are hereby adopted and promulgated, thus:

1. Certificate and associate programs in maritime education i.e. Certificate in Marine Engineering/Transportation (CMT/CME) and Associate in Marine Engineering/Transportation (AMT/AME) shall be terminated effective School Year 2000-2001.
2. Students enrolled in the certificate and associate programs in maritime education shall be allowed to finish their studies until SY 1999-2000.
3. Henceforth, effective SY 2000-2001, students desirous to pursue maritime education shall enroll only in the bachelor's degree programs in maritime education i.e. BS Marine Engineering (BSMarE) and BS Marine Transportation (BSMT).

This CMO shall take effect immediately.
