**SUBJECT: NEW REGULATIONS ON THE AUTHENTICATION OF
SCHOOL RECORDS FOR OVERSEAS FILIPINO
WORKERS IN JORDAN**

The Commission on Higher Education has received new requirements by the Jordan's Council of Higher Education (JCHE) regarding the verification and authentication of school records of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFW) in connection with the renewal of their respective residency and working permits.

This Office conveys the requirements of the JCHE, to wit:

1. The applicant should secure a "letter of confirmation" from the originating schools. The letter should state that the authenticated documents (diploma, transcript of records and other related school records) genuinely originated from a particular school. JCHE has apprised Post on this matter in view of the "deficiency" in documents being submitted by OFW nurses in Jordan in connection with the renewal of their respective residency and working permit.
2. JCHE still requires, in addition the submission by the OFW concerned in particular nurses, of a corresponding letter of confirmation from concerned schools to ensure genuineness and/or correctness and/or non-tampering of data/information contained in the diploma, transcript of records, and other pertinent school records.

It is requested that this guidelines be widely disseminated for the information, guidance and implementation of all concerned.
