The abovementioned institutions shall be subject to regular monitoring and assessment. If found not complying with or not maintaining the standards, they shall be delisted from the CHED list submitted to IMO.

However, following is the list of 1998-1999 qualifiers identified in CMO No. 34, s. 1999 that have not been visited due to the peace and order situation in Mindanao:

The abovementioned institutions that have not been visited shall be monitored and if found not complying with or not maintaining the standards shall be delisted from the CHED list submitted to IMO.


All other maritime institutions with at least substantially compliance with the requirements per listings of CHED Memorandum Order No. 34, s. 1999 shall be given up to April 15, 2001 to fully comply with CHED and STCW '95 requirements. Otherwise, their programs shall be phased-out effective SY 2001-2002.

The above-mentioned maritime institutions upon full compliance with the requirements shall be included in the issuance of additional list of maritime institutions which have fully complied with STCW '95 requirements.

All other maritime programs not listed in this order and the succeeding additional list shall be phased-out effective SY 2001-2002. Therefore, no first year students shall be allowed to enroll. Furthermore, currently enrolled students shall be assisted to transfer to other maritime institutions in this list.

This Order shall supersede CMO No. 34, series of 1999 - List of Maritime Institutions which Fully Complied with STCW '95 Requirements.
