The abovementioned programs shall be phased-out effective SY 2001-2002. Hence, no first year students shall be allowed to enroll in the abovementioned programs. Furthermore, currently enrolled students shall be assisted to transfer to other maritime institutions listed in CMO 8, s. 2001 and CHED additional list.

However, upon full compliance of the STCW '95 and CHED requirements, the abovementioned programs can be re-opened effective SY 2002-2003.

Meanwhile, the institution has the option to convert said program/s to the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) Courses, provided said courses has its authority from TESDA.
