

CHED MEMORANDUM ORDER (CMO)

No. 57

SUBJECT : COLLEGIATE ACADEMIC CALENDAR
FOR AY 2007 – 2008

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the “**Higher Education Act of 1994**,” and pursuant to Resolution No. 218, s. 2001, the ***Calendar for Academic Year (AY) 2007 – 2008*** for the collegiate level is hereby recommended, thus:

- A. As a general rule, the opening of classes for all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) shall not be earlier than the 1st Monday of June or later than the 4th Monday of the same month of the calendar year.
- B. Specifically, the following dates and periods shall apply,
 - 1. The collegiate academic calendar for AY 2007-2008 will begin on Monday, 11 June 2007, and will end on 15 March 2008. Collegiate school days shall consist of not less than eighteen (18) weeks per semester and six (6) weeks for summer classes, excluding Christmas vacation, semestral and summer breaks. The said school days shall include examination days and class days which may be suspended due to natural or man-made causes.
 - a. The first semester will start on 11 June 2007 and will end on 13 October 2007;
 - b. The second semester will start on 29 October 2007 and will end on 15 March 2008; and
 - c. Summer classes will start on 31 March 2008 and will end on 13 May 2008.
 - 2. Christmas vacation will begin on 23 December 2007 and will end on 06 January 2008.

- C. In addition to the regular and special public holidays recognized by law (Sections 26 and 27, Chapter 7, Administrative Code of 1987), HEIs may observe school holidays, provided that the minimum collegiate school days within a semester or summer stated in B.1 hereof are strictly followed and provided, furthermore, that the minimum length of actual student contact time of seventeen (17) hours, inclusive of examinations, shall be observed for every one-unit collegiate academic credit.
- D. HEIs, including those offering graduate degree programs, adopting the trimestral and quarterly systems may establish their own academic calendars and opening days provided the concerned CHED Regional Office (CHEDRO) is properly informed in writing of their particular schedules, and provided further that the required minimum number of class hours and class days herein set forth are met.
- E. HEIs using alternative instructional delivery modes may establish their own academic calendar and opening days provided the concerned CHEDRO is properly informed in writing of their particular schedules and delivery schemes and/or modules, and provided further, that such programs to be offered via said delivery schemes have prior approval of the Commission en banc.
- F. The Collegiate Academic Calendar for AY 2007-2008 and the distribution of class days by weeks/months per semester and summer are hereby enclosed for the guidance of all concerned.
