THIRD SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON POPULATION
EDUCATION FOR INSPECTORS IN TEACHER TRAINING
COLLEGES AND THE ARTS AND SCIENCES

To: All Bureau Directors, the Coordinator of the State
Colleges and Universities, and Heads of Offices
Concerned:

1. Two Summer Training Programs on Population Education for
instructors in public and private teacher-training colleges and instructors
in schools of arts and sciences will be conducted at the PEP Training Center,
Marikina School of Arts and Trades, Marikina, Rizal, from April 7 to May 9, 1975.

2. The primary objective of the aforementioned programs is to
prepare the instructors to teach population education either as a separate
course or as integrated in the social science and health courses of the
teacher education and the arts and sciences curricula.

3. There will be forty-five participants in each training program.
The participants of the first program will come from the following
institutions:

- a. One instructor of either social science or health from
each of the following state colleges:

- (1) Cagayan Valley College of Arts and Trades,
Tuguegarao, Cagayan

5. Participants in these programs should be chosen on the basis of the following criteria:

- a. not more than 37 years of age
- b. physically and mentally capable
- c. have strong leadership potentials
- d. willing and committed to teach population education in their respective schools and colleges for at least two years.

6. Heads of Offices concerned are requested to submit the names of their respective participants to the Department of Education and Culture Population Education Program, Arroyo, Manila, not later than March 15, 1975.

7. Participants are advised to bring with them copies of the syllabi of the course/courses they are presently teaching.

8. Each participant will receive a stipend of thirty-five pesos (P35.00) a day for the duration of the training. Their transportation expenses in going to and returning from the training site at Marikina, Rizal will be reimbursed by the Population Education Program, subject to existing auditing rules and regulations.

9. Preferential attention to this matter is desired.
