ANNOUNCING THE SERIES OF BILINGUAL SEMINARS

To: The Director of Public Schools,
The Director of Private Schools,
The Director of Vocational Education,
The Director, Institute of National Language, and
The President, State Colleges and Universities:

1. A series of seminars on bilingualism will be held in the different parts of the country, particularly in the non-Tagalog areas, under the joint sponsorship of the Panhangaang Samahan sa Linggwistikang Filipino, Inc. (PSLG), the Institute of National Language (INL), and the Department of Education and Culture. This is in accordance with Department Order No. 25, n. 1974, and with the authority granted by the Office of the President to the INL dated October 22, 1974, to conduct in-service training on Bilingualism. Attached hereto is the schedule of the series of seminars.

2. The series of seminars aims to bring to Filipino teachers in out-lying places of the country, especially teachers in Social Studies, Work Education, Health Education, Physical Education and Filipino in the non-Tagalog areas, the most recent developments in 1) the implementation of the bilingual policy, 2) current trends in the teaching of Filipino, and 3) the status of the preparation of teaching materials in the subject areas for Filipino. Filipino experts from the Filipino Division of the Bureau of Public Schools, Institute of National Language and the Panhangaang Samahan sa Linggwistikang Filipino, Inc. will compose the panel of speakers.

3. A registration fee of ₱25.00 per each participant will be charged. Every participant will receive a kit containing the following: 1) Filipino vocabularies in Social Studies, 2) Filipino vocabularies in Work Education, 3) Filipino vocabularies in Health Education, 4) Filipino vocabularies in Physical Education, and 5) the topical papers of the speakers, and other handouts related to the seminar.

4. Teachers in Social Studies, Work Education, Health Education, Physical Education, and Filipino, as well as administrators of programs in Filipino, are encouraged to attend these seminars. The registration fee for attending the seminar is to be borne by the participant, but the attendance is official and with credit.

5. All inquiries relative to the course of seminar should be addressed to: The President, Panalipung Samahan sa Diagwistikong Pilipino, Inc., c/o Philippine Normal College, Taft Avenue, Manila.

6. It is requested that this Department Memorandum be given priority attention and dissemination.
