CONFERENCE OF SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS

TO: The Director of Public Schools
The Director of Private Schools

1. The 1975 Conference of School Superintendents will be held on April 12-18 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the Conference is "Towards a Deeper Commitment to the New Society". In accordance with the program herewith enclosed, the Conference starts with a Courtesy call on His Excellency, the President, at Malacañang, on Saturday, April 12, at 9:00 a.m.
2. Division/City Superintendents of Schools or Officers-in-Charge of divisions, private schools regional superintendents, vocational schools superintendents, superintendents of normal schools/colleges under the Bureau of Public Schools, and Chiefs of divisions in the General Office are authorized to attend this Conference. Other officials not specified above, whose services may be required at the Conference, will be duly notified and given proper authority by this Office.
3. Presidents and officers-in-charge of State Colleges and Universities are invited to attend this Conference.
4. Enclosed is the program for the Conference. The group sessions are expected to produce proposals for strategies, programs, projects or curricular adjustments


as would develop among students, teachers, school administrators and other schools' officials a stronger sense of commitment to New Society goals. It is desired, in this connection, that participants concerned come to the Conference prepared with proposals to insure a fruitful discussion.

5. A session is scheduled for status reports of Regional Directors on the implementation of department policies and programs as well as regional development plans and projects. The reports should be brief but comprehensive.

6. Officials not covered by paragraph 2 hereof who are members of the Philippine Association of School Superintendents (PASS) and those to be invited as PASS members may be authorized to attend the Conference upon recommendation of their respective Bureau directors or heads of offices.

7. Conference registration fee is ₱100.00. Travelling expenses of participants are chargeable against funds of their respective offices.

8. Immediate dissemination of this Department Memorandum is heretby desired.
