SUPPORTING THE 1975 PHILIPPINE NATIONAL

TO All Bureau Directors

OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES
PROCLAMATION No. 1362

DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 15 TO APRIL 30, 1975
FOR THE TWENTY-EIGHT ANNUAL FUND CAMPAIGN OF
THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RED CROSS

WHEREAS, the Philippine National Red Cross, the body corporate officially designated under Republic Act No. 55, as amended, to assist the Republic of the Philippines in discharging its obligations set forth in the Geneva Convention and to perform other functions inherent in a national Red Cross society, depends solely upon voluntary public contributions to carry out its duties and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, in accordance with its charter, any contribution to the Philippine National Red Cross annual fund campaign shall entitle an individual to membership for one year; and as a national voluntary organization, the Philippine National Red Cross is financed primarily by contributions received through personal solicitation campaigns; and

WHEREAS, the said organization has proven itself an indispensable institution in the promotion of the public welfare, especially in times of emergency, symbolizing our national spirit of compassion;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALFREDO MOLINA, Executive Secretary, by order of His Excellency, FERDINAND R. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the period from January 15 to April 30, 1975, for the Twenty-Eighth Annual Fund Campaign of the Philippine National Red Cross for contributions and membership. I urge all citizens and residents of this country as well as all associations and organizations, to help actively in this campaign by giving generously of their means, time and effort and by joining the humanitarian organization as members in order to realize the aims and purposes of the Philippine National Red Cross.

I authorize all national, provincial, city, municipal, and barrio government officials and school authorities to accept Philippine National Red Cross fund-raising responsibilities, and urge them to take the initiative and assume active leadership in the Red Cross fund and membership campaign in their respective communities.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 10th day of December, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
