SPECIAL INTELLIGENCE OFFICERS' COURSE
FOR SECURITY OFFICERS

TO: THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS,
THE DIRECTOR OF PRIVATE SCHOOLS,
THE DIRECTOR OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION, and
THE PRESIDENTS OF STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 51, dated November 16, 1972, Amending Portions on National Security of the Integrated Reorganization Plan, and Letter of Implementation No. 52-B, dated January 17, 1973, and Department Order No. 13, s. 1973, the National Intelligence and Security Authority (NISA), Quezon City is conducting a seven-week Special Intelligence Officers' Course exclusively for the Department of Education and Culture starting April 7, 1975. The qualifications of the candidates for this Course are as follows:

- (a) Senior officials slated to be assigned as head and/or assistant head of security units or senior officials whose functions require knowledge of civil security;
- (b) natural born Filipino citizens;
- (c) have the trust and confidence of the head of office;
- (d) have proven loyalty and integrity in the public service;
- (e) at least a college graduate;
- (f) not more than 55 years old as of the year of admission;
- (g) cleared for security by the NISA; and
- (h) will pass the written and oral examinations to be given by the NISA.
