ONE-WEEK TRAINING PROGRAMS ON POPULATION  
EDUCATION FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

To: BUREAU DIRECTORS  
AND HEADS OF OFFICES CONCERNED:

1. One-week training programs on population education for public and private secondary school teachers will be conducted simultaneously in selected Provincial Training Centers starting July, 1975 and ending March, 1977.
2. Participants and trainors will be categorized as follows:
  - Category 1. Public (BPS and JPS) and private secondary school teachers trained by SITMs of the Public Schools.
  - Category 2. Private secondary school teachers trained by SITMs of the Bureau of Private Schools.
  - Category 3. Public and private secondary school teachers trained by SITMs coming from any two of the three Bureaus (BPS, BVS, BPTS).
3. The participating schools and their respective delegates as well as the venue of each training program will be chosen (1) jointly by the Division/City Superintendent of Schools, Superintendent for Vocational Education and the Regional Superintendent for Private Schools for Categories 1 and 3, and (2) solely by the Regional Superintendent for Private Schools for Category 2. In any province with two or more Superintendents (BPS, BVS, and BPTS), the Superintendent of public schools in the division where the Training Center is located will be the Coordinator.
4. Ten (10) teachers in each subject area (Social Studies, Health, Science, Mathematics, and Home Economics) or a total of fifty (50) teachers from selected public (BPS and BVS) and private secondary schools

within the province will participate in each program. Ideally, a school should send five participants (1 for each subject area) to any of these training programs. However, a big high school may send eight (8) participants, while a small one may send a minimum of three participants depending on the actual needs and manpower potential of the school concerned. To avoid any disruption of classes in any school, one or two teachers may be trained at a time.

5. Participants residing in the city or town where the training program is held will each receive a stipend of ₱5.00 per day, those coming from other towns and cities will each receive ₱10.00 per day, while a trainer will receive a stipend of ₱17.00 per day.

6. Programs for retraining the STTs for secondary school teachers listed in the Inclosure will be held at the PEP Training Center, Marikina School of Arts and Trades, Marikina, Rizal on the following dates:

- a) May 19-21, 1975 for Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, and XI
- b) May 26-28, 1975 for Regions I, II, III, IV, and V

7. Supervisory Training Teams (STTs) are enjoined to prepare accurate listings of public (BPS and BV&E) and private secondary schools in the provinces (cities included) and the number of teachers by subject areas in each school prior to the retraining programs. These data will be needed in the preparation of action programs for training in their respective stations.

8. Transportation expenses in going to and returning from Marikina, Rizal, with a stipend of ₱35.00 per day will be provided by the PEP subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

9. Preferential attention to this matter is desired.
