BOOKS FOR CHINESE LANGUAGE IN  
CHINESE SCHOOLS

To: THE DIRECTOR OF CHINESE SCHOOLS:

1. The attention of this Office has been invited to the fact that some Chinese schools are still using imported Chinese textbooks for language arts that do not conform "the goals and objectives of the 'De' Society".
2. Two (?) sets of books entitled "Language I and II" submitted by the General Association of Chinese Schools in the Philippines have been provisionally reviewed by this Office for use in Language Arts; Language I for Grades 1-4 in the Elementary course and Language II for First to Fourth Years of High School in all Chinese schools in the Philippines effective the school year 1974-75. These books have been evaluated and found to be acceptable for use in Chinese schools.
3. It is desired that this Department Circular be disseminated immediately to all Chinese schools for their information and compliance.
