SUMMARY REPORT OF SITE VISITATION

TO: The Director of Public Schools,
The Director of Vocational Education,
The Director of Private Schools, and
The Officers in-Charge of Region IV.

1. The National Executive Committee of the Green Revolution, National Food and Agriculture Council (NFAC), United States Agency for International Development (USAID), University of the Philippines at Los Baños (UPLB), and the Department of Education and Culture (DEED) will jointly sponsor a Seminar-Workshop on Seed Production at the Rizal National Agricultural School, Davao, Mindanao, on June 16-20, 1975 and at the Green National Agricultural School, Pagbilao, Quezon on July 7-11, 1975.

2. The main objective is to upgrade the skills and competencies of Elementary Garden Teachers, Secondary Food Production Teachers, both private and public, Division Food Production Coordinators and Food Production Teachers of Vocational Schools and the involvement of all school administrators and other school personnel in the production of quality vegetable seeds.

3. Each division/schools concerned shall send to the seminar-workshop two elementary garden teachers, one food production supervisor, one food production teacher for each secondary school (private and public) and one food production teacher for each vocational school (agriculture, trade and fishery).

4. All participants in the seminar should be at the seminar site one day before the date of the seminar. A registration fee of 130.00 will be charged from each delegate.

5. Transportation and other expenses of public school principals and teachers in their attendance in this seminar-workshop will be charged against local division/school funds; those coming from the Department will charge their expenses from the Department of Education and Culture travel funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. With respect to private school participants, private schools concerned are strongly urged to provide for their expenses.

6. A program of activities for the seminar and a list of provinces where the school divisions, and schools are located are attached for the guidance of all those concerned.
