FUND CAMPAIGN OF THE ZARZUELA  
FOUNDATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: The Director of Elementary Education,  
The Director of Secondary Education,  
The Director of Higher Education,  
The Coordinator, State Colleges  
and Universities, and  
The DEC Regional Directors:

1. Enclosed herewith is a copy of Proclamation No. 1356 of the Executive Secretary dated December 3, 1974, authorizing the Zarzuela Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. to conduct a nation-wide fund campaign during the period from January 1 to December 1, 1975.

2. The Proclamation specifically "calls upon all citizens and residents of the country, irrespective of nationality, race or creed, to assist in the endeavor by giving generously of their means and to actively support the campaign." The President, in the same Proclamation, also calls upon all cultural organizations of the country to assist the foundation in its laudable objectives.

3. Considering that the Proclamation allows solicitation of contributions for such a worthy cause, this Office strongly endorses this fund campaign. It is requested that all efforts be exerted to the end that pupils, students, teachers, and other school personnel give liberally to the Foundation. It is also requested that the educational phase of the campaign be stressed tracing the history of the zarzuela as one of the most cherished forms of entertainment among the Filipinos during the Spanish and American periods. Today, under the New Society, the First Lady and a group of civic-spirited citizens have exerted efforts towards the revival of this almost forgotten culture of the Philippines.

4. The initial offering of the Foundation and Pacifica Productions will be the socio-political zarzuela entitled "Minda Rosa" which will be presented on July 4, 1975, at the Cultural Center of the Philippines. Tickets for the much-awaited show which will be sponsored on this date by the Department of Education and Culture will be made available to you soon.

5. It is desired that the contents of this Department Memorandum be brought to the attention of the schools, teachers, and employees under your jurisdiction for their information and guidance, and that appropriate steps be taken immediately for its effective implementation.

6. Kindly send all contributions and donations to the Office of the Undersecretary, Department of Education and Culture, Arroceros, Manila.

AUTHORITY LETTERS FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES,  
D.R.C. TO SUPPORT A NATIONAL FUND DRIVE LAUNCHED  
BY THE FILIPINO MAGULO NG FILIPINAS  
FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO DECEMBER 31, 1975.

WHEREAS, the Kamalik Foundation of the Philippines, Inc. is a cultural organization established by a group of civic-minded citizens and voluntary businessmen committed to the revival, formation, propagation and presentation of the Filipino nationalism, which is one of the most cherished forms of citizenship among the Filipinos in the Commonwealth until 1935;

WHEREAS, the Foundation has taken steps towards pursuing the basically revised "newman" of the country through successful production in line with the Administration's cultural program; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectively continue its noble objectives, the Foundation needs the financial and moral support of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. M. T. B. MUNOZ, Executive Secretary, by order of His Excellency, FERNANDO R. SARRABES, President of the Philippines, do hereby authorize the REPSUEÑA FOUNDATION OF THE PHILIPPINES, D.R.C. to conduct a fund campaign during the period from January 1 to December 31, 1975, to raise from all citizens and residents of the country, irrespective of nationality, race or creed, to assist it in its endeavor to give the government of their means and to sincerely support the revision. I further call upon all cultural organizations in the country to assist the Foundation in its laudable objectives.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
