TENTH TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SUPERVISORY TRAINING  
(STTs) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND  
CULTURE POPULATION EDUCATION PROGRAM

To: ALL REGIONAL DIRECTORIES AND

1. The tenth training program for Supervisory Training Teams (STTs) of the Department of Education and Culture Population Education Program (PEP) will be held at the Marikina School of Arts and Trades, Marikina, Rizal, from June 23 to July 25, 1975.

3. Participants shall be selected in accordance with the following criteria:

\* Should send only one participant

\*\* Should send only one participant coming from Dipolog City

- a. Not more than 57 years old
  - b. Physically and mentally capable
  - c. Willing and committed to conduct training programs for the next two or more years
  - d. Have strong leadership qualities
  - e. Not slated for any scholarship for the next two school years
- b. Names and designations of participants should be submitted to this Office on or before June 10, 1975.
- c. Transportation expenses in coming to and returning from the training site as well as stipend of P35.00 per day for each participant will be paid by the Population Education Program subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
- d. Preferential attention to this matter is desired.
