APPOINTING THE PHILIPPINE TUBERCULOSIS  
SOCIETY TO CONDUCT THE 1975 NATIONAL  
EDUCATION AND FUND CAMPAIGN

TO: All Bureau Directors,  
Heads of Offices,  
Regional Directors, and  
Coordinator, State Colleges & Universities;

1. Enclosed herewith is Presidential Proclamation No. 1383 of the Executive Secretary dated February 17, 1975, authorizing the Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc. to conduct a National Educational and Fund Campaign during the period from February 15 to December 31, 1975.

2. The Proclamation specifically calls upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines regardless of nationality of creed, to support actively and give generously of their means to the Anti-TB cause so as to hasten control of this impoverishing and highly communicable disease and thereby minimize human suffering amongst the poor who, in our humane and compassionate country, need not be underprivileged or abandoned."

3. Considering that the Proclamation allows solicitation of contributions for such a worthy cause and in view of the improved and effective fight against tuberculosis in the form of domiciliary visits, especially in the rural and/or overcrowded areas, this Office strongly endorses this fund campaign. It is requested that all efforts be exerted to the end that school officials, teachers and faculty members, students and pupils of all schools, colleges, and universities, as well as supporting school personnel, give liberally to the Society. It is also requested that the educational phase of the campaign be stressed tracing the history of this dreaded disease from the Spanish and American periods to the present.

PROCLAMATION NO. 1588

APPOINTING THE PHILIPPINE TUBERCULOSIS SOCIETY, INC.  
TO CONDUCT A NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL AND FUND RAISING CAMPAIGN  
DURING THE PERIOD FROM FEBRUARY 15 TO DECEMBER 31,  
1975.

TUBERCULOSIS, tuberculosis continues to harass a large  
segment of our population, thus hindering the growth of  
the national economy and the social upliftment of the  
masses;

NECESSARY, the urgency of controlling tuberculosis,  
still the 10, 2 killer-disease in the country, is vital  
to the improvement of the public health;

NECESSARY, only the unremitting moral and financial  
support of the entire nation can accelerate the concerted  
efforts of the National Government and the Philippine  
Tuberculosis Society, Inc. in intensifying material  
amelioration and medical relief to indigent victims;

NOW THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND MARCHOS, Executive  
Secretary, by order of His Excellency, FERDINAND M.  
MARCHOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby authorize  
the Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc. to conduct its  
national educational and fund-raising campaign during the period  
from February 15 to December 31, 1975.

I call upon all citizens and residents of the  
Philippines regardless of nationality or creed, to  
support actively and give generously of their means to  
the noble cause so as to hasten control of this  
insidious and highly contagious disease and  
thereby minimize human suffering amongst the poor who,  
in our humane and compassionate community, need not be  
underequipped or abandoned.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have caused this my said pro-  
clamation to be signed and the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be  
affixed.
