THE 1975 NATIONAL REGIONAL CONVENTION OF THE JUNIOR  
CHILDREN OF THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM AND LIBRARY, INC.

To: The Director of Schools / Education,  
The Regional Directors, and  
The Coordinator, State Colleges &  
Universities

1. The Junior Council of the Children's Museum and Library, Inc. Foundation (JCMFL) will sponsor the 17th annual national convention of its members on October 1-11, 1975 at the Peralta Camp, Laguna City. The theme of the convention is "Youth Faces the Challenges of Today."

2. The convention is intended to give the youth a better perspective of their role in the area of nation-building through lectures, group discussions, group reports, movie film showings, literary-mediated contents, and other activities.

3. Participants in the convention are requested to observe the following requirements:

a.) Payment of P1,400.00 - convention fee per delegate/teacher-adviser to cover food and lodging for the duration of the convention and the cost of covered materials.

500.00 - delegate's junior membership fee

1,000.00 - teacher-adviser's membership fee

b.) Transportation expenses from their respective schools to Laguna City and back will be borne by the delegates and teacher-advisers. For the trip to Manila of delegates from Central, Mindanao, and Southern provinces, the assembly point will be in front of the JCMFL Youth

Center, adjacent to the Manila City Hall, on Amorsolo  
St., Manila at 9:00 a.m. on November 5, 1975, and  
will arrive in Baguio at 11:30 a.m. THE MEMBERS  
SHOULD REPORT WITH THEIR OWN TRAVEL BAGGAGE TO  
MAGNIFICENT.

- 1.) From the previous sessions they are held to prepare  
the delegates and their teachers for the  
forthcoming. In these meetings they should study  
well the articles on group and social studies and be  
guided by the progress of activities. Good questions  
may be directed to them on the time and the sub-  
jects. Because of the benefits that the students can  
derive from these sessions, their attendance way  
be asked to attend.
- 2.) After arrival in Baguio, the teacher-advisors and  
delegates with the endorsement of the school principal,  
should initiate the holding of pre-conferences in the  
schools of the delegates to which may be invited stu-  
dents from other schools in the locality. The mate-  
rials used in Baguio City may be used for this pur-  
pose.
- 3.) The schools should send to the national convention three  
(3) voting delegates and two (2) non-voting delegates  
with the teacher-advisors. All of them should be properly  
selected and coordinated by the schools they represent.  
Last year's delegates who are up in their senior year  
and their teacher-advisors should be encouraged to at-  
tend the conferences.
- 4.) To facilitate the holding of registration, the enclosed  
forms should be fully completed and submitted with  
the corresponding fees on or before Sep. 30, 1975.

4. Considering the importance of the convention in training  
the youth for leadership, it is enjoined that school and training  
students, school groups, student leaders and school paper editors  
from secondary schools, both public and private, be encouraged  
to participate in this assembly.

5. Teachers-advisers may participate in the aforementioned convention on official time only.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Department Memorandum is hereby desired.
