OBSEVATION OF THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY
OF UNP UNITED NATIONS

To: The Bureau Directors,
The Regional Directors, and
The Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities

1. The United Nations will celebrate its fiftieth anniversary with activities on October 24, 1975 in coordination with its various agencies and government departments.

2. In conformity with the request of the Secretary of Foreign Affairs, the United Nations Association of the Philippines (UNAP) and the Department of Education and Culture will observe this significant event precisely on October 24-25.

3. To those for this year's UN celebration is dedicated the observance of International Literacy Day (ILD).

4. The goals of the UN are as follows: (1) equal rights and responsibilities of all men; (2) full participation of men in the development of society in all spheres of man; and (3) man's full involvement in and development of humanity without any classes or strengthenings social classes.

5. However, each agency/institution may substitute one above, objectives, or its own specific objectives with its needs to promote literacy among children,青年, 师生, parents and all citizens in the basic principles and objectives of the UN Charter as well as the UN's contribution to world peace, security and development.

6. As representative bodies about the UN and the various programs of its related agencies, we understand, e.g., as literary-musical programs, academic or local, cultural stage plays, book, symposia, forums, conventions, debates and the like.

7. Active participation of all members, Negro and others,
is to be observed at all Book meetings.

8. Significant activities under the direction of the Negro
should be included in the weekly report of the church.

9. If it is desired that this Report be published, be given wide
publicity in all existing publications and media.
