CONFERENCE WORKSHOP ON FRUIT CROP PROPAGATION
AND GARDENING PROGRAM OF THE SCHOOLS

To: The Regional Directors:

1. A Conference Workshop on Fruit Crop Propagation and Gardening Program of the Schools sponsored by JELB-project in cooperation with the Bureau of Elementary Education will be conducted on August 1-10, 1975 at U.P. Los Baños, Laguna.
