DECLARING 1976 AS DIAMOND JUBILEE YEAR COMMEMORATING
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CONTEMPORARY PHILIPPINE
EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

1. Enclosed herewith is Presidential Proclamation No. 1474 dated August 6, 1975, "Declaring 1976 as Diamond Jubilee Year Commemorating the Establishment of the Contemporary Philippine Educational System."
2. Seventy-five years of Philippine education will be celebrated nation-wide starting January 23, 1976. This date was chosen by His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, as the Diamond Jubilee Day in commemoration of the date of the enactment of Act No. 24 of the Philippine Commission, although actually the proclamation has set aside the period from January 1 to December 31, 1976, as the Year of the Celebration. It is suggested, however, that the closing day of the celebration be held on December 30, 1976, to coincide with the celebration of Rizal Day.
3. The President, in his proclamation, specifically "calls upon all government entities and instrumentalities to participate in the celebration and invite private institutions and individuals to join in making the celebration fruitful."

4. The theme of the celebration is: "EDUKASYON PARA SA NATIONALED UNANG KALAHING KALUMULIN" ("Education For National Development"), with the following as sub-themes:

a. Education for National Development Through Nationalism

b. Education for National Development Through Regional Unity

c. Education for National Development Through Economic Growth and Productivity

d. Education for National Development Through Right Thinking

e. Achieving Unity and Development Through Love, Loyalty, Sacrifice, and Technology as well as Technical and Vocational Education

f. Education for Health, Standardizing, and Unity

g. Education for Academic Discipline and Moral Values.

5. The objectives of the celebration are the following:

a. To commemorate the diamond jubilee year of the Philippine Educational System established under Act No. 14 of the Philippine Commission;

b. To inform the people of the achievements of the Phillipines in education and of the progress resulting upon that education;

c. To explore possibilities for further growth and advancement of the system; and

d. To promote international understanding through education.

6. The following are the 30 founding institutions of the Confederation:

For the purpose of convenience during the first year of the said time allotted, all Government established under Article 17 of the Philippine Constitution, a Planning Committee was organized to draw up a comprehensive plan of activities and programs appropriate, progressive and suitable for the welfare and development of the Confederation. The Planning Committee, composed of the Undersecretary of Education and Culture and the Associate Secretary,

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Chairman and Vice-Chairman, respectively, with all Bureau Directors and Heads of Offices under the Department of Education and Culture as well as Presidents of Educational Institutions and Associations, as Members, was constituted by the Proclamation into a National Committee of the Celebration charged with the preparation and implementation of the year-long program to make it more meaningful. The following are the approved activities of the year-long Celebration:

- a. Zambukal Parade on January 21, 1976
- b. Educators' Conference
- c. Educational Exhibits or Festivals
- d. Commemorative Medals and Stamps
- e. Radio Broadcasts and TV Telecasts
- f. Printed Media
- g. National Jubilee Seal
- h. Song Writing Contest
- i. Symposia and Seminars
- j. Awards for Outstanding Educators

In view of the nature and scope of the Celebration and due to the reorganization of the Department of Education and Culture, it is requested that the event be observed and continued on the regional basis. Each regional director shall assume responsibility in the observance and conduct of the Celebration in his/her region and make every effort to insure that the provincial/city Superintendences under his/her jurisdiction extend their full cooperation and assistance. It is suggested that each region develop its own themes based on the theme and sub-themes adopted by this Office.

10. It is desired that the contents of this Department's Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned and that a report be submitted to this Office on how the Proclamation was implemented by each division in the different regions.

PROCLAMATION No. 1474

DECLARING 1976 AS DIAMOND JUBILEE YEAR COMMEMORATING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CONTEMPORARY PHILIPPINE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, 1976 is the seventy-fifth anniversary of the establishment of the Philippine educational system under Act No. 74 promulgated by the Philippine Commission on January 21, 1901;

WHEREAS, the Philippine educational system has to a great extent contributed to the growth and development of the country;

WHEREAS, it is desirable to apprise the people of the achievements of the Philippines in education and of the progress she has made through education;

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to indicate lines of further growth and advancement of the system as an instrument of national development; and

WHEREAS, educators in and out of the government have made representations for the proper observance of the seventy-fifth anniversary of the establishment of the Philippine educational system and for setting aside the period from January 1 to December 31, 1976, as the year of the celebration;

BEST, THEREFORE, I, MIRIAM E. MACABOG, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby proclaim the period from January first to December thirty-first, Nineteen hundred and seventy-six, as the "Diamond Jubilee Year to commemorate the establishment of the Philippine Educational System" under Act No. 74 of 1901.

I call upon all government entities and instrumentalities to participate in the celebration and invite private institutions and individuals to join in making the celebration fruitful.

The Decree further declares May 21, 1975, as the Diamond Jubilee Day in commemoration of the date of the enactment of Act No. 74 establishing the Philippine Educational System.

The Education Week being observed in September of every year under Proclamation No. 123 dated April 22, 1949, shall be made to coincide with the Diamond Jubilee Celebration.

The following are hereby constituted into a national committee on the diamond anniversary of Philippine educational system charged with the preparation and implementation of a year-long program to make the celebration meaningful:
