75th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE
PHILIPPINE CIVIL SERVICE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator of State Colleges & Universities

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 235, dated August 12, 1964, Civil Service Week is celebrated every year from September 15 to 19. This year's celebration is highly significant since it commemorates the 75th year of the establishment of the Philippine Civil Service. The theme for the Diamond Jubilee Celebration is "75 Taong Paglilingkod sa Bayan."
2. It is suggested that several activities highlight the celebration. These on-the-spot writing contests, drama, musical and agency programs, and giving the granting of Legion of Service Awards to deserving employees with 20, 30 or 40 years of continuous service, and conferment of Honorary and Meritorious Awards in accordance with Department Circular No. 34, s. 1959.
3. It is further suggested that school, district, and/or division programs be held in each region, specifically the granting of Legion of Service Awards and Honorary and Meritorious Awards to deserving employees.
4. Regional directors are enjoined to disseminate the contents of this Department Memorandum and submit a report on activities undertaken in compliance after the celebration. Attention is invited to the attached Memorandum Circular No. 1, s. 1975, which is self-explanatory.

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS,
BUREAUS, OFFICES AND AGENCIES
OF THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL
GOVERNMENTS, INCLUDING
GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND CONTROLLED
CORPORATIONS

SUBJECT : Diamond Jubilee (75th Anniversary) Celebra-
tion of the Philippine Civil Service

This year a significant milestone will be marked by the Philippine Civil Service System -- the 75th anniversary of its establishment. The occasion will provide us, who constitute the country's civil service, with an opportunity to take a look at what the System has achieved during the past 75 years of its existence and at the same time to re-dedicate our efforts toward the maintenance of an honest and responsive public service under the New Society.

The observance of Civil Service Week which, pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 285, dated August 13, 1964, falls on September 13-19, therefore, gains added significance this year.

In this regard, all departments, bureaus, offices and agencies of the national and local governments, including government-owned and controlled corporations, are hereby urged to hold appropriate programs, activities and ceremonies directed at focusing public attention on the importance of the civil service and the role of public servants in national development.

The theme for the Diamond Jubilee celebration is "75 Taong Paglilingkod sa Bayan."

Specifically, all concerned are requested to extend full support and cooperation to the following activities already lined up for the occasion:

1. Departmental and agency programs during the Week, including the granting of Length of Service Awards to deserving employees.

2. Conferment of Honorary Awards to outstanding public servants on September 19. Details of the awards notes will be announced later.
3. Regional Institutes on the Civil Service in September, October, and November, 1975, as authorized under Memorandum Circular No. 844 dated June 17, 1975 of the Office of the President. This will be jointly sponsored by the Personnel Officers Association of the Philippines and the Law Center of the University of the Philippines. Particulars of the Institutes have been circularized by the Personnel Officers Association of the Philippines.
4. On-the-Spot Essay Writing Contest for government employees on August 18, 1975 sponsored by the Society of Developmental Information Officers. Teams of Offices are encouraged to send participants to this contest. Details of the contest may be obtained from the Contest Committee, DDI-Region IV, 2nd Floor, Herald Building, Macalino, Intramuros, Manila.

The above activities refer only to those which have already been firmed up as of the time of the issuance of this Circular. The cooperation and support of all concerned are also requested to other nation-wide activities which are being contemplated for the occasion and which this Office shall announce from time to time.

Finally, it is suggested that agency heads should take steps to have banners displayed at the facade of their respective offices and building or any other conspicuous place in their office premises.
