3. Personnel on detail with this project shall receive a monthly stipend to be determined by UNICEF in addition to their basic pay. In addition to monthly stipends, personnel on detail working from outside the teacher family base shall receive a monthly allowance to be determined by UNICEF and shall further be entitled to one round-trip fare to and from their home station.
