3. Personnel on detail with this project shall receive a monthly stipend to be determined by DDCI/AM, the equivalent of \$1 in basic pay. In addition to monthly stipends, personnel on detail in the field outside the Greater Montevideo area receive a monthly allowance to be determined by DDCI/AM and shall further be entitled to one round-trip fare up and down their home station. Those assigned to field work shall be entitled to the usual transportation allowances and per diems in accordance with existing military rules and regulations.
