OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL STUDENTS' WEEK  
ON SEPTEMBER 20-27

To the: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges  
and Universities

1. Conformably to Presidential Proclamation No. 1316 of the Executive Secretary dated September 20, 1972, National Students' Week will be observed on September 20-27. Schools, colleges, and universities are enjoined to carry out youth activities in connection with community development; Green Revolution; nutrition education and the campaign for proper food habits; cooperative, consumer, taxation, and population education; "Magimpok" campaigns; physical fitness and sports development; development of moral values; anti-hazing campaign; and other YCAP projects.

2. It will be noted that the Proclamation cites Manila's Outstanding Goods as one group of Filipino students signifying "their dedication to spearheading youth projects in line with the government policies and strengthen the bond between the students, the youth, and the government." This year, Manila's Outstanding Goods, through their Love Bank, are again pursuing meaningful student undertakings geared to community development and nation-building. They will sponsor and conduct the "Hakbang Love Bank," an "ayaw-lakad" for the benefit of the relocted squatters of the Greater Manila Area. The Executive Board of Manila's Outstanding Goods will also convene this year a National Students Conference to crystallize the youth's aspirations and responsibilities. Full cooperation and assistance to Manila's Outstanding Goods' projects, particularly their Love Bank projects, will be appreciated.

3. Wide dissemination of this Department Handbook is desired. An account of the observance of National Students' Week should be included in the annual reports of regional directors and school superintendents.

PROCLAMATION NO. 1310

PROCLAMING SEPTEMBER 20-27 AS NATIONAL STUDENTS' WEEK.

WHEREAS, there is a further need to harness and direct students' energy and cultivate their creativity towards community development and total nation-building;

WHEREAS, such student activities such as the Manila's Outstanding Good have signified their dedication toward spearheading youth projects, in line with the government policies, and strengthen the bond between the students, the youth, and the government;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ALFREDO MELCHOR, Executive Secretary, by order of His Excellency, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby proclaim September 20-27 as National Students' Week.
