ANNOUNCING THE UP INSTITUTE OF ENVIRONMENTAL
PLANNING GRADUATE PROGRAM IN URBAN
AND REGIONAL PLANNING

1. The Institute of Environmental Planning, University of the Philippines, is now accepting applications for admission to its graduate program for the second semester of school year 1975-1976 leading to a master's degree in Urban and Regional Planning (URP).

2. The graduate program aims at training professional planners to meet the needs of a developing country like the Philippines. It stresses the comprehensive nature of Urban and Regional Planning and its relevant role in national development.

3. Qualified officers and employees of the national departments and agencies, including corporations and local governments, may pursue a graduate program as scholars of their respective offices or agencies in accordance with Memorandum Circular No. 156, of the Office of the President, dated February 9, 1968.

4. This program replaces the old Master in Environmental Planning (MEP) courses started in 1968. It has both a full-time and part-time program of study conducted in the daytime and evening, respectively.
