NATIONAL AND REGIONAL CONFERENCES OF THE FUTURE FARMERS AND
THE FUTURE AGRICULTURAL HOMEMAKERS OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC.

To the:

Bureau Directors,
Regional Directors

1. For the information and guidance of the field, there is inclosed with this Memorandum, a schedule of regional conferences of the Future Farmers and the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines, together with the Program of Activities of the National Organization of the Future Farmers of the Philippines, Inc., and the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines, Inc. for the school year 1975-1976 which will serve as guides in preparing the activities of the region and the school chapter.
2. Also inclosed is the revised National and Regional Directory and Organization of the Future Farmers of the Philippines, Inc., and the Future Agricultural Homemakers of the Philippines, Inc., for the school year 1975-1976.
3. Upon receipt of this Memorandum, the chairman of the Board of Directors for the region should convene the members of the regional advisory councils or heads of schools in the region for a preparatory conference to prepare the program of activities, the program of work, and budget of the organization for a two-day regional work conference to be hosted by the school as previously decided by the old FFP-FAHP district board. The National Advisor should be officially notified of the date of the two-day work conference so that the national executive secretaries of the two organizations may be properly advised to attend the regional work conference.
4. Student-delegates should be limited only to the outstanding members who will participate in competitive activities and who are prospective candidates to a regional and/or national office.

5. It may be stated that the joint national conference approved by the Executive Secretary on June 11, 1976, was originally scheduled on June 24-26, 1976. It was postponed in view of the reorganization of the Department of Education and Culture. This national work conference is proposed to be held on January 7-8, 1976, in Manila.

6. It is suggested that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible. All member schools should be given copies of it for their information and guidance.
