DECLARING VALID AND LEGAL THE 1971 VOCATIONAL AND PRIVATE  
SCHOOLS SUPERINTENDENT'S EXAMINATIONS AS WELL AS THE  
1972 DSC TEACHERS EXAMINATIONS

1. Inclosed is a copy of Resolution No. 59, s. 1975 of the Civil Service Commission, declaring the validity and integrity of the Vocational Schools Superintendent examination given on September 25, 1971, the Private Schools Superintendent examination given on November 20, 1971, and the Teachers' examination given on May 27, 1972. In this Resolution, dated September 24, 1975, the Civil Service Commission recognizes these examinations and those who qualified therein are, therefore, considered civil service eligibles.
2. All previous appointments carrying these eligibilities and attested as "provisional" should be re-submitted through this Office for attestation to permanent appointments as prescribed in Sections 23 and 24 of Republic Act No. 2260, as amended by R.A. No. 6040.
3. Immediate dissemination of this Department Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.

RESOLUTION NO. 59, SERIES OF 1975

WHEREAS, on September 25, 1971, the Department of Education and Culture conducted the Vocational Schools Superintendent examination and on November 20, 1971, it conducted the Private Schools Superintendent examination;

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1972, the Department likewise gave the Teachers' examination, holding examinations in all provincial capitals;

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission was informed of these examinations and extended assistance to the Department of Education and Culture in the conduct of these examinations;

WHEREAS, these examinations were conducted in accordance with the authority granted under Section 23 of Republic Act No. 2260, as amended, which provides that the Department of Education and Culture is authorized to give "appropriate examinations for public school teachers with the assistance of the Civil Service Commission" and under Paragraph 5, Article III, Chapter II, Part III, of the Integrated Reorganization Plan which likewise provides that "technical, professional, and scientific courses which are unique within a department shall be the responsibility of the Department concerned";

WHEREAS, in a letter to the Commission dated September 16, 1975 and on September 22, 1975, the Secretary of Education and Culture certifies that the conduct of examination was regular and proper and there is nothing to impair their validity and integrity.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Civil Service Commission, in view of the foregoing, considers the Vocational Schools Superintendent examination given on September 25, 1971, the Private Schools Superintendent examination given on November 20, 1971, and the Teachers' examination given on May 27, 1972, to have been conducted in accordance with law and since the Department of Education and Culture has certified that there is nothing that would impair their validity and integrity, hereby recognizes these examinations and those who qualified therein are considered civil service eligibles.

RESOLUTION NO. 59

The Commission further RESOLVES to request the Department of Education and Culture to submit the names of those who qualified in these examinations to be entered into the corresponding register of eligibles.
