FIRST NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE UNITED NATIONS
ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

1. The First National Convention of the United Nations Association of the Philippines (UNAP) will be held on December 9-10, 1975, at the Centro Escolar University Auditorium, in celebration of Human Rights Day. The Convention is under the joint sponsorship of the UNAP, the Department of Education and Culture, the Department of Foreign Affairs, the UNESCO National Commission of the Philippines, the Department of Public Information, and the National Media Production Center.

2. The theme of the Convention, which is intended to focus on the observance of International Women's Year (IYW), is: "More Effective Integration of Women for National Development."

3. The Department of Education and Culture regional directors, provincial/city superintendents of schools, presidents and heads of colleges and universities, who are members of UNAP, are urged to attend the convention.

4. Expenses incident to this convention, including transportation and car hire, as well as a minimum registration fee of ten (10) pesos, will be charged against the local funds of the respective offices, subject to availability of funds and the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

5. Included herewith is the program of activities for the Convention.

6. It is desired that this Department Memorandum be disseminated for compliance of all concerned.
