1975 ATOMIC ENERGY WEEK

1. Atomic Energy Week will be celebrated this year on December 7-13, 1975. The theme for the celebration, according to the Philippine Atomic Energy Commission (PAEC), which has taken the lead in the national observance, is "LAKAS ATOMIKA, BAGONG LAKAS, BAGONG PAGASA" (Atomic Energy: New Strength, New Hope).

2. To promote awareness of nuclear science among school children as well as college and high school students, it is desired that schools, colleges, and universities observe the Week by arranging appropriate activities with various technological societies and with the regional offices of the Science Foundation of the Philippines. A documentary film of the Philippine Atomic Energy Commission may also be arranged for showing in local theaters and on television.

3. In the Greater Manila Area, the main sites of the celebration will be at the PAEC compound, Alibon, Quezon City, where there will be a daily open house of the PAEC laboratories and offices, film showing, exhibits, and lecture demonstration series. The peaceful uses of atomic energy will also be featured.
