SUBSIDIZING SUPPLEMENTARY FEEDING PROGRAM

To the: Regional Directors
Superintendents of Schools

1. In connection with the one-day a week (or its equivalent) feeding to which schools with CARE supplementary feeding program are committed (DEC Memo. No. 169, s. 1975), all concerned are reminded to upgrade school food production projects, and tap community resources both public and private.

2. Solving malnutrition through supplementary feeding is basically a phase of continuing research on the production and utilization of indigenous food crops and the study of proper food combinations and substitutions. This program aims to change food habits of the Filipino citizens, thus resulting in attitudinal changes in our citizenry.

3. Superintendents and district supervisors, who are chairmen of local school boards, may get funding from the Special Education Fund (R.A. No. 5447, Section 3, h and i) as contribution to the school supplementary feeding program (CARE malibun).

4. The fund needed may be included under "education research", provided, however, that such appropriation shall not unduly prejudice the other activities under R.A. No. 5447.
