NATIONAL SEMINAR ON EDUCATIONAL INNOVATIONS
FOR DEVELOPMENT

1. The Department of Education and Culture, in cooperation with UNESCO and with the assistance of Unesco National Commission of the Philippines, Philippine American Educational Foundation and Foundation for Assistance to Private Education, will conduct a National Seminar on Educational Innovations for Development on January 5-6, 1978, at the ~~Bojales~~ Hotel, Manila. The National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education, a special unit of the IEC, shall coordinate this Seminar.

2. The objectives of this Seminar are:

- a. To bring together innovators in education, as well as in other fields, and provide them a forum for exchanging their experiences and knowledge, and
- b. To examine the planning, management, and implementation of innovative projects in order to synthesize insights and understandings and crystallize therefrom functional concepts of social change in the educational context.

3. Utilizing selected innovative projects submitted by the field in response to the IEC-UNESCO Projects for a National Inventory on Educational Innovations, the Seminar intends to disseminate knowledge and understanding of concepts, processes, structures, problems and needs involved in educational innovations, and prepare the ground for planning strategies and action programs to improve the quality and relevance of Philippine education to contemporary Philippine society.

4. Assistant Secretaries, Bureau Directors, Regional Directors, Chiefs of Staff Services, and members of the National Development Group for Educational Innovations are authorized to attend this Seminar. Expenses incurred for this Seminar, including transportation and per diem, will be charged against the local funds of respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Constraints in funds and of arrangements make it necessary to limit participation on this occasion but follow-up regional seminars are contemplated.

5. Inclosed herewith is a tentative program of the Seminar. All enquiries therewith shall be addressed to Dr. Alfredo N. Stocales, Director, National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education, Department of Education and Culture.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
