SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SEED PRODUCTION

1. The National Executive Committee of the Green Revolution, National Food and Agricultural Council (NFAC), United States Agency for International Development (USAID), University of the Philippines at Los Baños (UPLB), Cooperative for American Relief Everywhere (CARE) and the Department of Education and Culture (DEED) will jointly conduct a seminar-workshop on Seed Production at the Speaker Ruperto Torres National Agricultural School, San Carlos City, Pangasinan on December 8-12, 1975 and at the Pangasinan National Agricultural School, Pangasinan, Ilocos Norte on December 15-19, 1975. Attached is a list of participating schools/divisions.

2. The main objective of this seminar-workshop is to upgrade the skills and competencies of elementary garden teachers, secondary food production teachers, (both private and public), division practical arts supervisors and food production teachers of vocational schools. The seminar-workshop will also involve all administrators and other school personnel in the production of nutritious vegetable seeds.

3. Each division/school specifier in the included list shall send to the seminar-workshop five (5) elementary garden teachers, one food production supervisor, one food production teacher for each secondary school (private and public) and one food production teacher for each vocational school (agriculture, trade and fishery).

4. All participants should be at the seminar early and stay before the date of the seminar. Registration fee of 500 will be charged each delegate. The registration fee will cover meals.

5. Transportation and other expenses of participants incurred to their attendance in this seminar/extension will be charged against local division/school funds. Travel coming from the Department office will be against expenses against the Department of Education and Culture travel funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. A tentative program of activities for this seminar and a list of provinces where the school divisions and schools are located are attached for the guidance of all concerned.
