REMITTANCE OF MEDICARE AND STATE
INSURANCE CONTRIBUTIONS

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Offices

1. There is hereby enclosed GSEB Memorandum Circular No. 182-75 which is self-explanatory.
2. Teachers whose positions are created by the Local School Boards should be deducted for the MEDICARE and the State Insurance contributions (employees contribution) and other usual contributions for as long as they are paid from the school board fund. Likewise, Local School Boards should pay for their share of the contributions.
3. All contributions to the MEDICARE and the State Insurance should be sent promptly and directly to the address specified in the letter.
4. Strict compliance of all concerned is desired.
