POSTDOCTORATE FELLOWSHIPS OFFER OF THE ROYAL NORWEGIAN
COUNCIL FOR SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH

1. For the information of all concerned, quoted hereunder is the Postdoctorate Fellowships offer of the Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research:

"The Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research has granted Postdoctorate Fellowships since 1957 to young foreign scientists wishing to undertake research work in Norwegian institutes. Through the years 1957-1975 altogether 214 candidates have been awarded Fellowships. Fellows have come from all parts of the world and have been working in various fields of applied science.

"Candidates should not be more than 35 years of age and have qualifications corresponding at least to a British or an American Ph.D. in science or engineering.

"FIELD OF STUDY

"The Postdoctorate Fellowship programme covers all fields of applied science and technology within the sphere of the Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research. Agriculture and medicine are excluded.

"Successful applicants will be able to join well established research teams at the Universities of Oslo, Bergen, Trondheim and Tromsø and at various institutes for applied research in the Oslo, Bergen, Trondheim areas.

"The Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research is prepared to assist successful candidates in establishing contact with appropriate research teams if necessary.

"DURATION OF STUDY

"Fellowships will be granted for a full year's research. Applications for renewal for a second year will be considered.

"LANGUAGE

"English may be used in all research teams; most teams will be able to accept German, and certain teams, French.

"AMOUNT OF STIPEND

"The annual stipend is at the moment Nkr 40 000 for single Fellows and Nkr 46 000 for married Fellows accompanied by their wife/husband. An additional Nkr 3 000 is granted for each accompanying dependent child. Stipends will be exempted from income tax in Norway.

"TRAVEL

"The Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research will cover personal travelling costs (1 class sea and railway, tourist class air) from European quarters. Fellows accompanied by their wives/husbands will receive an additional allowance of half of the travel grant.

"Fellows coming from quarters outside Europe are asked to cover travel expenses from other sources. Grants to cover part of these transportation costs may be applied for from this Council.

"APPLICATION

"Application Forms and further information may be obtained from the ROYAL NORWEGIAN COUNCIL FOR SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH, Gaustadalleen 30, Oslo 5, Norway. Applications for the 1976/77-programme should reach this Council not later than January 1st, 1976. Successful candidates will be notified by April, 1976."

2. It is requested that this Fellowship offer of the Royal Norwegian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research be given the widest publicity.
