EDUCATION GRADUATE EXAMINATION

The College of Education of the University of the Philippines announces the holding of the Education Graduate Examination for applicants to the graduate programs (masteral and doctoral) for Summer, 1976. The examination will be administered on January 31, 1976, in the College of Education, Diliman, Quezon City at 8:00 A.M. Qualified to take the examination are applicants who have satisfied the following requirements:

Masteral Program:

1. A bachelor's degree in Education (BSE, BSSED.) or in other field (AB, BS) from the University or from institutions of recognized collegiate standing, with a general weighted average of 2.75 or better.
2. At least three references: one from a former major professor, one from his program/research adviser, and one from a former or current employer (if any) indicating their evaluation of his potential for graduate work.

Doctoral Program:

1. A general weighted average of "2", "B", "BB", or better in the undergraduate level.
2. At least two years of successful professional experience in education or in allied fields.
3. A superior command, oral and written, of the English language. In the case of a foreign applicant whose native language or medium of instruction is not English, he must pass a language proficiency test.
4. Possession of qualities and potentials for leadership as shown in his statement of purpose, references and other pertinent documents.

Application forms may be secured from the Office of the Secretary, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City. The completed application forms together with the credentials required should be filed with the Office of the Secretary not later than January 24, 1976. An application and testing fee of P10.00 will be charged of applicants who are citizens of the Philippines while applicants who are non-citizens will be charged P50.00.
