FOURTH SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS ON POPULATION
EDUCATION FOR INSTRUCTORS OF TEACHER-
TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

1. The Department of Education and Culture Population Education Program (PEP) shall conduct simultaneously two summer training programs in population education for instructors in public and private teacher-training institutions and arts and sciences at fifty (50) participants to each program in order to prepare them to teach population education as a separate course, or integrate population education in the social science and health education courses of the teacher-education curricula.

2. Institution-participants shall integrate population education into their respective syllabi.

3. Instructor-participants shall come from the following institutions/offices:

- a) Two instructors of either social science, or health education shall come from each of the following institutions:
 - 1) Central Mindanao University, Marikina, Bukidnon
 - 2) Pampanga State University, Marikina, Manila
 - 3) Cagayan Valley Institute of Technology, Cagayan, Isabela
 - 4) Don Mariano Marcos Memorial State College, Marikina, La Union
 - 5) Nueva Vizcaya State Institute of Technology, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya

- 6) Pablo Borja Memorial Institute of Technology, Balanga City
- 7) Palawan National Agricultural College, Aborlan, Palawan
- 8) L'empanggo Agricultural College, Magaling, L'empanggo
- 9) Rizal Technological College, Pasig, Rizal
- 10) Boro' Agriculture College, Silar School

- b) Sixty-nine (69) participants shall come from the private teacher-training institutions and arts and sciences
- c) One regional office social science supervisor in higher education
- d) One general office staff development supervisor of higher education

4. Teacher-training institutions and arts and sciences in the provinces that have not participated in previous PPT training programs shall be given priority in the selection of participants for the 1976 summer training programs.

5. Participants shall be chosen in accordance with the following criteria:

- a) not more than 37 years of age
- b) physically and mentally capable
- c) have leadership potential
- d) willing and committed to undertake population education activities for at least two years

6. Name and designation of participants should be submitted to the Population Education Program, Department of Education and Culture, Manila on or before February 15, 1976.

7. Participants should bring with them copies of the syllabi of courses they are presently teaching.

8. Each participant shall receive a stipend of thirty-five pesos (P35.00) per day for the duration of the training. His transportation expenses in going to and returning from Marikina, Rizal will be reimbursed by the Population Education Program subject to existing accounting and auditing regulations.

9. Preferential attention to this matter is desired.
