SUMMER IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR TEACHERS
AND INSTRUCTORS OF FISHERIES

To the:

Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The second summer in-service training program for teachers and instructors of fisheries in fishery schools and colleges will be conducted at the Marikina School of Arts and Trades, Marikina, Rizal from April 19 to May 18, 1976 in consortium with the U.P. Systems College of Fisheries, Diliman.
2. Fishery schools and colleges should send the teachers and instructors who attended this program last summer, 1975. Just like the first training, three teachers/instructors will be sent; one in Fish Capture, one in Fish Culture and one in Fish Processing. There will be three groups. Each will deal on their field of specialization.
3. It is decided that the names of teachers and instructors be sent to this Office immediately to give ample time for planning further details of the program.
4. This program involves a three-point approach of upgrading teachers' competencies by: (1) acquainting them with latest techniques and modern processes in various phases of the fishery industry, (2) providing them with on-the-job training and/or experiences in fishery enterprises. Subject matter content in fisheries education shall be presented through a series of lectures to be followed by open forum. Practicum sessions are to be provided to afford actual practice in one's field of specialization in well-established fishery enterprises in Greater Manila, (3) offering of the three major concentrations in fisheries namely: fish culture, fish capture and fish preservation with 2½ hours lecture and 1½ hours laboratory.

5. Resource persons in this program will be composed of experts or fisherfolk from the S.P. College of Fisheries, Bureau of Aquatic Resources, Fishery Commission and from private agencies connected with fishery activities.

6. Participants are allowed traveling expenses and per diem charges against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. A registration fee of ₱500 will be charged each participant in this training program to cover the honorarium of personnel and supplies and materials to be used.

7. The contents of this Department Memorandum should be made known to all concerned for their information and guidance.
