EDUCATIONAL BROADCASTS RESTRUCTURED

To the: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. In conformity with the aim of educational broadcasting which is to promote national development through formal, non-formal, and informal education, the school broadcasts are being restructured for more flexibility.
2. Starting the school year 1976-1977 the school broadcasts shall not be the conventional lesson by lesson material beamed to schools over the air but an inquiry-oriented package to be worked out by ad hoc unit under the Director of Elementary Education. In this connection, it will be appreciated if the educational media supervisors and coordinators collect the annual broadcast evaluation reports from the listening classes in the division and tabulate, interpret and briefly summarize the result in one page before forwarding the one-page evaluation summary to the Director, Bureau of Elementary Education. Effective immediately, all communications about the above broadcasts should be addressed to the Director, Bureau of Elementary Education.
3. For more effective broadcast impact, radio receivers and TV sets may be purchased from any available local school funds.
4. It is required that the contents of this Department Memorandum be disseminated immediately for the information, guidance, and compliance of all concerned.
