AMENDMENTS TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP  
RULES AND REGULATIONS

To the: Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges  
and Universities

1. In view of the recent developments, the following amendments to the rules and regulations as printed in the SSP Manual of Information are hereby made for the information and guidance of all officials involved in the State Scholarship Program administered by the National Scholarship Center of this Office:

- a. All scholar graduates effective March 1975 are entitled to board review privilege to cover their review fees and two months living allowances of P210 per month.
- b. Scholars enrolled in Chemistry who are required to take chemical research are entitled to two hundred pesos ... (P200) as chemical research allowance effective school year 1975-1976.
- c. Scholars who are supposed to graduate in the ensuing school year are allowed to enjoy summer privilege school fees and allowances if their remaining subjects exceed the maximum load in their last curriculum year.

d. The State Scholarship award is an automatic grant, hence the awardees should be given the full amount covering monthly allowances due them, exclusive of school fees which should be paid by the Office or the Local School Board, as the case may be. No receipts should be required.

e. The gross income requirement of parents of candidates for scholarship is increased from \$10,000 to \$12,000 per annum effective school year 1977-1978.

2. It is requested that implementation of these policies be made immediately to avoid untoward effects on the State scholars.
