DEPARTMENT MEMORANDUM

DECLARES THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 7 TO 14, 1976
AS "LOVE BANK WEEK"

1. Enclosed herewith is Proclamation No. 1529 of the President of the Philippines dated January 27, 1976, declaring the period from February 7 to 14, 1976 and every year thereafter as "Love Bank Week."

2. Love Bank Week is aimed at emphasizing the role being played by our youth and students in community development and nation-building.

3. The Love Bank which was initiated in 1973 by Manila's Outstanding Goods was made part and parcel of the celebration of Students' Week (September 20-27) by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 1316 and Department Memorandum No. 327, s. 1975.

4. The President in his Proclamation specifically enjoins all government agencies, private organizations, residents, and students to extend every possible assistance to youth and student activities that will help realize the aspirations of our youth.

5. Love Bank this year will undertake the following youth/student projects/activities in the Greater Manila Area: population, nutrition education and the campaign for proper food habits, cooperative, consumer, taxation, city population education, "Mag-impek campaigns," physical fitness and sports development programs, moral values, and aid and assistance to the squatters of Constitution Hill in Quezon City.

6. It is suggested that similar organizations in the field be encouraged to be formed to emulate the activities spearheaded by the Love Bank conformatly with the drive of the First Lady for compassion and relevant student/youth involvement in the projection of the New Society.

7. It is requested that wide dissemination of this Department Memorandum be made and, as an account of the importance of Love Book Week be included in the annual reports of superintendents of schools and DEC regional directors.

DECARING THE PERIOD FROM FEBRUARY 7 TO 14, 1976
AND THEREIN SHALL BE KNOWN AS "LOVE BANK WEEK"

WHEREAS, a sizeable segment of our youth and students are actively engaged in community development, social concern, wider education, sports and athletic development through civic projects initiated by the Love Bank - a youth organization;

WHEREAS, the activities spearheaded by the Love Bank are in line with the drive for compassion and relevant student involvement in the projects of reforms of the New Society;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the administration to consider youth as an object of development, as a resource for development, and as a responsible member of society, hence, recognizing and encouraging the direction toward relevance being taken by the studentry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the period from February 7 to 14, 1976, and every year thereafter as "LOVE BANK WEEK" to emphasize the role being played by our youth and students. I enjoin all government agencies, private organizations, residents, and students to extend every possible assistance to youth and student activities that will help realize the aspirations of our youth.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
