ELEVENTH ANNUAL BIOTA CONVENTION

1. The Biology Teachers Association of the Philippines (BIOTA, Philippines) and the Department of Education and Culture (DEC) will jointly sponsor the Eleventh Annual Biota Convention which will be held at the University of Nueva Caceres in Naga City on March 26, 27, and 28, 1976.
2. The theme of the Convention is: "The Biologist in Regional Development." During the three-day convention, seminars and workshops will be conducted on the following: abaca and bamboo craft, ceramics, fish preservation, Green Revolution, sugar technology, and Livestock management.
3. Each division/school may send to the Convention, on official time only, one elementary school garden teacher, one practical arts supervisor and/or teacher, one science teacher, one teacher in biological sciences, and one food production teacher from the secondary schools. With respect to private school participants, private schools concerned are urged to provide for their expenses.
